AUTUMN AT CITY GREEN FIELD TRIPS



City Green Field Trips take place at our Learning Farm at City Green's Farm Eco-Center and at our Learning Garden in Paterson's Eastside Park. Fall field trips are offered September 25th to November 1st, every Wednesday and Friday between the hours of 9:30am-12:30pm.

Field trips are available to ages PreK-4th Grade with a max of 35 students per group. Cost is \$5-\$11 per student and determined by the school's free/reduced lunch percentage.

As students rotate through activity stations, they will get to plant seasonal produce, observe farm animals and native wildlife, engage in a garden to table activities, and have a lot of fun outdoors in a beautiful garden setting. Program material will be adapted to your groups age range. **See below for topics and activities included in this years' field trips!**

STATION 1: SEED YA LATER

Save the seeds! Students will learn the benefits of seed-saving by preserving seeds from our native flowers, and explore the cool-weather crops in our fall garden.



STATION 2: WHO LIVES HERE?

Let's go birding! Students will identify New Jersey birds through their calls, examine the relationship between birds and the garden habitat, and learn about migratory paths as native wildlife prepare for winter.



STATION 3: FRUITS OF FALL

Come enjoy the sweet taste of fall! Students will discuss variety and seasonality in produce, the benefits of eating locally grown fruits and vegetables, and put their skills to the test to make fresh apple cider.
